

4. ENCORE PRESENTATION: Life and Love of Max and Ava Fernekes Dinner and Presentation

Internationally renowned art historian Cliff Krainik returned to the Walker House on October 24, 2015 for another sold out illustrated dinner presentation on the Life, Love, and Art of Max and Ava Fernekes. This dinner presentation coincided with the final days of the Fernekes art exhibit at the Pendarvis Historic Site in Mineral Point. The exhibit included 31 original Fernekes art works.

Artists Max and Ava Fernekes came to Mineral Point in 1940 and established their studio in a quaint Cornish stone house. For the next 50 years they produced a vast and varied body of artistic expression recording the history and beauty of their community.

This past July Krainik gave his first presentation on the art and love of the Fernekes to a sold out audience at the Walker House, and he added new material to the October presentation to entertain and enlighten new guests as well as those who attended the first presentation.
